TRAVERSE Flex-Pack: Warehouse Management - TRAVERSE Warehouse Management has new enhanced shipping functionality, allowing the user to create specific shipping instructions. We'll also cover blind shipments and the new Bill of Lading features. **2 hour session**

TRAVERSE Inventory for Flexible Packaging - In this two-hour session we will review the enhanced User Defined Fields functionality, learn about the changes for Production Standard Unit of Measures, the addition of the Roll and Skid Label Kits and much more. **1 hour session**
